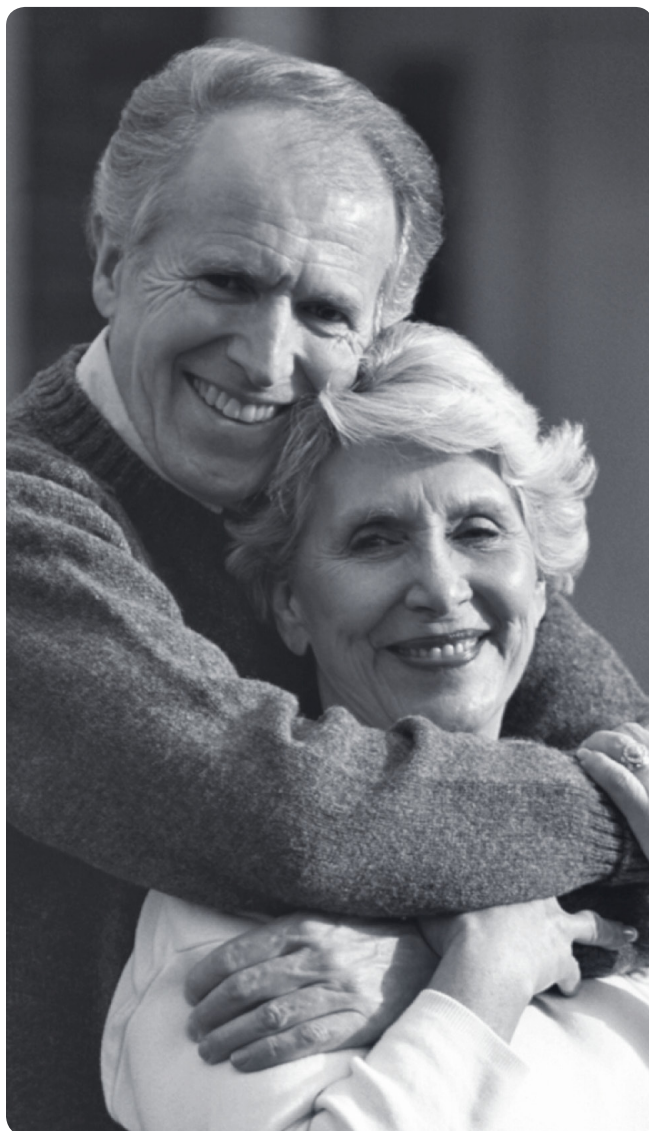

Professor Emeritus, Director, Eve Topf Center, a National Parkinson Foundation Center of Excellence for Neurodegenerative Diseases Research and Teaching at Technion Israel Institute, Haifa, Israel; Distinguished Professor, World Central University, Yonsei University, Seoul, Korea, Distinguished Chair Professor, PolyU and Hong Kong University, China. Over 500 publications in peer-reviewed journals. Dr. Youdim is the winner of the Life Sciences 2010 EMET Prize for Brain Sciences. This prize was awarded to Professor Youdim for his achievements in the field of neurological studies. The EMET Prize is an annual one million dollar award sponsored by the A.M.N. Foundation for the Advancement of Science, Art and Culture in Israel in cooperation with the Prime Minister of Israel.
